Tres Report - Profit and Loss Statements for July and August Reported. Savings, Checking, CD, and Halle Restoration Accounts Now total \$50, 252. Report accepted as presented – Point of order on Donation to St. Maxmillon Kolbe Ministries for Electrical Work done by Jeremy Itz on the Halle. Final amount was not presented to membership for vote and was above \$500 Threshold in Bylaws by Steve Montgomery.

Kate Roos Development Director – Presentation to the Society on Stewardship. Kate gave a brief history of her own background as a machinist for GE and her love of fine Craftsmanship. Used examples of her father's love of antique restoration to emphasize the need for all to make the most of their time, talents and treasure to motivate the membership to their best in using what we are and have to help benefit others. Offered an open invitation to the membership to assist in the Parish Stewardship efforts. Carlos Added comments regarding the Hill Country during the depression and the stewardship that was offered to many a homeless person (Hobos) that frequently traveled thru the Hill Country and Fredericksburg via Hiway 87. Gave examples of Signs that these people used to indicate homes where good stewards could be found along their journey. In those times it was not Government that helped these souls out but individuals out of the virtue of Stewardship.
