Hall Restoration

- Randy Stehling reported on the current status of the hall restoration project. He discussed a first draft of the Building Program. Randy encouraged members to look ahead 50-100 years, think outside of the box, and pray for success of the project and the society itself. Randy indicated that the first step is done developing a first draft of the project based on input from members. Step 2, program approval, should be completed by next month. We are waiting to complete the building documentation. Stehling stated that we should have preliminary cost estimates by that time.
- Darin Holmes reported that St. Joseph's Society's Board and Building Committee met with Rick McManigle of the Hill Country Community Foundation on Friday, Jan. 23. The Board is considering opening an account with the Community Foundation to provide a vehicle for administering the Hall Restoration Project. with experienced asset managers sitting on the oversight committee. The 501 (C) (3) status of the foundation opens doors to fundraising.
